

## QUIT-CLAIM DEED.

COMPARED

THIS INDENTURE, Made, this 28th day of May in the year A. D. 1911 between  
Ada Oil Company, a corporation  
 of the first part, and The Sasmallen Oil Company, a corporation and  
J. A. Cain  
 of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That the said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One  
1 DOLLARS,  
 to it duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do est hereby quit-claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto  
 the said party of the second part, and to their successors heirs and assigns, forever, all its right, title, interest and estate, both  
 at law and in equity, of, in and to the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa  
 and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The west half of northwest quarter of the  
northwest quarter, and the southeast quarter  
of the northwest of the northeast quarter (NW 1/4 of  
NW 1/4 of NE 1/4 and SE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of NE 1/4) of section  
eight (8) township twenty one (21) north, range  
thirteen (13) east; also

NE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of NE 1/4 of section eight (8) township  
twenty one (21) north, range thirteen (13) east

The above land is hereby quitclaimed under
