## QUIT-CLAIM DEED.

 the said part 2 of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns, forever, all his right, title, interest and estate, both  
 at law and in equity, of, in and to the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa  
 and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

SW 1/4 of NE 1/4 and NW 1/4 of SE 1/4 and NE 1/4 of SW 1/4 Section  
19, Township 19, Range 11, and 1/2 of NW 1/4 of NE 1/4 of NE 1/4  
and SW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of NE 1/4, and 1/2 of NW 1/4 of NE 1/4  
and SW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of NE 1/4, and 1/2 of NW 1/4 of NE 1/4  
Sections 19, Township 19, Range 11, same being allotment  
including homestead of Maggie Littleton, a Freed-  
man citizen of the Creek Nation, and Northwest quarter  
of Section 19, Township 19, Range 11, same being allotment, in-
