QUIT-CLAIM DEED.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 27th day of January in the year A. D. 1911 betweenMarcus L. Lockwood of Tulsa, Oklahomaof the first part, and H. M. Gibson

of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That the said part 1st of the first part, in consideration of the sum ofOne Dollar (\$1.00)

DOLLARS,

to him duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby quit-claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part 2^d of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns, forever, all his right, title, interest and estate, both at law and in equity, of, in and to the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa

and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Southwest Quarter (S.W. 1/4) of the Southeast quarter (S.E. 1/4) of the Northeast quarter (N.E. 1/4) of Section Twenty-three (23) West one-half (1/2) of Southwest quarter (S.W. 1/4) of the Northwest quarter (N.W. 1/4) of Section Twenty-four (24) and Northwest quarter (N.W. 1/4) of the Northeast quarter (N.E. 1/4) of the Northeast quarter (N.E. 1/4) of Section Twenty-six (26) Township Twenty-two North (22 N.) Range Twelve (12) East.

This deed is made for the purpose of releasing any and all rights which the said party of the first part has acquired under and by virtue of a certain oil and gas mining lease executed by Jeanie Hampton to said Marcus L. Lockwood as her date of January 27th 1906 and approved by the Honorable Secretary of the Interior November 19th 1906 and filed for record March the 16th 1907 in the office of the Deputy United States Clerk and Ex-officio Recorder in record 9, page 126 Tulsa Indian Territory.

The party of the second part in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable considerations to him in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby accept the above release and quit-claim of the above described property in full satisfaction of any and all rights accrued or to accrue to him under the above described lease.
