QUIT-CLAIM DEED.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 8th day of February in the year A. D. 1912 between Clifton George of the first part, and Charles W. Robinson of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That the said part 1st of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable considerations DOLLARS, to him duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do he hereby quit-claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part 2d of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns, forever, all his right, title, interest and estate, both at law and in equity, of, in and to the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

and Ex. Officer Recorder at Claremore, Oklahoma Feb. 3, 1906 and I hereby  
covenant and agree that that I have no claim or right, in  
or to the same.
