## QUIT-CLAIM DEED.

 and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

All my interest in and to the N.E. 1/4 of Section (15),  
and the South half of the South West Quarter of Section Two (2), Town-  
ship Nineteen (19), North Range Eleven (11), East, said interest being  
the interest heretofore purchased from John Gooden, heir at law of  
Misna Gooden, Bartton deceased. The above described land being  
the allotment heretofore allowed by the U. S. Government to Nancy  
Gooden nee Nancy Jones, deceased.
