QUIT-CLAIM DEED.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 18th day of January in the year A. D. 1912 between
John Fields of the first part, and *Leora Perkins*

 to *Leora* duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, doth hereby quit-claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto
 the said party of the second part, and to *her* heirs and assigns, forever, all right, title, interest and estate, both
 at law and in equity, of, in and to the following-described real estate, situated in the County of *Tulsa*
 and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The northeast quarter (1/4) of Section Sixteen (16) Township
 Eighteen (18) North, Range Thirteen (13) East, Tulsa County,
 Oklahoma, containing 100 acres, 22 rods or less.

This deed is given to correct a mistake wherein
 E. W. Arnold executed this day a quit claim deed to
 John Fields on the above described land, wherein the
 grantee was named John Fields, whereas the true intention
 of all parties was that said grantee should be
Leora, Perkins

together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging. To have and to hold the above-granted premises unto
 the said party of the second part *her* heirs and assigns, forever.
