One undivided one half interest in and to the southeast quarter of section thirty six (36) Township 19 North, Range 10 East of the Indian Base and Meridian, Tulsa County, Oklahoma according to the United States survey thereof.

There having been various court proceedings had and made in the matter of the title to the above described property, now it is mutually understood and agreed that of the said property there is in Charles Page an undivided one half interest and in P. A. Jarry an undivided one half interest and this instrument is made for the purpose of evidencing said facts.
