QUIT-CLAIM DEED.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 18th day of October in the year A. D. 1909 between C. G. Goodale and Ida M. Goodale, his wife, of Collinsville, Rogers County, Oklahoma, parties of the first part, and James W. Dunn and Mary E. Dunn, of Owasso, Oklahoma, parties of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred and no (200.00) Dollars, duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby quit claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said parties of the second part, and to their and all their heirs and assigns, forever, all their right, title, interest and estate, both at law and in equity, of, in and to the following described real estate, situated in the County of and State of Oklahoma, to wit:

A certain tract of land, beginning at the Northeast corner of the Northwest quarter (1/4) of Lot One (1) in Section Thirty (30), Township Twenty-one (21) north, range Twenty-four (14) East, the line running in a westerly direction two hundred sixty seven (267) feet along the South line of Section Thirty (30), thence running south at right angles to this line a distance of two hundred sixty seven (267) feet thence running east parallel to the North line a distance of two hundred sixty seven (267) feet thence running north along the East line of the Northwest quarter (1/4) of Lot One (1) a distance of two hundred sixty seven (267) feet to the point of beginning. This land being located in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and containing one and one half acres, more or less.

together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging. To have and to hold the above granted premises unto the said James W. Dunn and Mary E. Dunn, their heirs and assigns, so that neither they nor said C. G. Goodale nor Ida M. Goodale his wife or any person in their name and behalf shall or will hereafter claim or demand any right or title to the said premises or any part thereof; but they and every one of them shall release, present and ever hereafter hold the same unconditionally to the said parties of the first part hereinabove set forth, the day and year first above written.
