QUIT-CLAIM DEED.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 23rd day of January in the year A. D. 1912 between
 Campbell Land and Oil Company, a corporation
 of _____ County, State of Oklahoma,
 of the first part, and The Uncle Sam Oil Company, a
 corporation,
 of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That the said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of
 One (\$1.00) DOLLARS,
 to it duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby quit-claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto
 the said party of the second part, and to its successors and assigns, forever, all the right, title, interest and estate, both
 at law and in equity, of, in and to the following-described real estate, situated in the County of _____ and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

A tract of ground being in the Northeast corner of
 Lot three (3) in Section eleven (11) Township Nineteen
 (9) North, Range twelve (2) East bounded and described
 as follows:—Beginning at a point on the South Bank
 of the Arkansas River, said point being sixty (60) feet
 North 63° 25' West of a point where the westerly right
 of way line of the St Louis and San Francisco Railroad
 Company intersects the North line of Lot Three (3) in
 Section eleven (11) Township Nineteen (9) North Range
 twelve (2) East, thence North 63° 25' West 68.16 feet
 to a point; thence South 67° 28' West 56.4 feet to a
 point; thence Southwesterly on a line parallel to said
 Right of Way line a distance of One Hundred (100)
 feet to a point; thence South 67° 28' East 56.4 feet
 to a point; thence South 63° 25' East 68.16 feet to a
 point; thence Northeasterly on a line parallel to, and sixty
