QUIT-CLAIM DEED.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 1st day of July in the year A. D. 1910, between

 to theirs duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby quit-claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto
 the said part of the second part, and to theirs heirs and assigns, forever, all their right, title, interest and estate, both
 at law and in equity, of, in and to the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa
 and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

That part of lot numbered four(4) in Block numbered two
 hundred(200) in the City of Tulsa, said county and state aforesaid
 beginning at the southwest corner of said lot numbered
 four(4) running thence in a northerly direction along the east line
 of said lot numbered four(4) a distance of 33 1/3 feet, thence easterly and
 at lines parallel with the north line of said lot numbered four(4)
 until it intersects the south line of said lot numbered four(4)
 thereof due east along the south line of said lot numbered
 four(4) to the place of beginning.
