The west half of the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of section 7 township 19 range 13 east also the west half of the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter and a strip of land 86 feet wide off the west side of the east half of the northeast quarter of the northeast quarter all in section 7 township 19 north range 13 east (except that portion heretofore deeded to Carl H. Magee) also the southwest quarter and the west half of the southeast quarter of section 7 township 19 range 13 east formerly in the Creek National Indian Territory but now of Forest Park Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma

together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging. To have and to hold the above-granted premises unto the said part of the second part, his successors and assigns, forever.
