

QUIT-CLAIM DEED.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 14th day of September in the year A. D. 1914 between H. B. Brockman and Louise Brockman, his wife of Tulsa, Oklahoma of the first part, and A. B. Lewis of Tulsa, Oklahoma of the second part:

together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging. To have and to hold the above-granted premises unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, forever.
