## RELEASE OF MORTGAGE.

of Tulsa, Oklahoma all the right, title, interest, claim or demand whatsoever, it may have acquired in, through or by a certain mortgage bearing date of May 19th 1906, and recorded in the office of records of Deeds at Tulsa, Indian Territory (now State of Oklahoma) in Book 1 of miscellaneous at page 137, to the premises herein described, as follows:

The southerly forty (40) feet of lot number one (1) and the northerly ten (10) feet of lot number two (2) in block number three (3) North Tulsa, Indian Territory (now State of Oklahoma) according to the plat of said North Tulsa as approved by the Secretary of the Interior April 16, 1904 and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point on West line of Boston Avenue 40 feet northwesterly from the southeast corner of lot one, in block three, running thence southwesterly parallel with southerly line of said lot one, 140 feet to the alley, thence along alley line southwesterly along West line of lot one and two, 50 feet, thence northwesterly parallel with northerly line of lot two, 140 feet to Boston Avenue, thence along easterly line of lot one and two, 50 feet northwesterly to place of beginning and all improvements thereon.
