RELEASE OF MORTGAGE.

L. Britton and his wife Lurie L. Britton of Tulsa, Oklahoma all the right, title, interest, claim or demand whatsoever, it may have acquired in, through or by a certain mortgage bearing date of June 20th 1902, and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds at Tulsa, Indian Territory (Now State of Oklahoma) in Book 1 at page 29, to the premises herein described, as follows:

The North Half of the North Half (1/2 of 1/2) of Lot Number Four (4) and the South Half of Lot Number Five (5) in Block Number One Hundred and Forty Four (144) in the Original Townsite of Tulsa, Indian Territory (Now State of Oklahoma) according to the United States Survey thereof, and allowing for the variation of the Townsite from the true meridian and all improvements thereon,
