## RELEASE OF MORTGAGE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the FARM AND HOME SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF MISSOURI, a corporation, organized and doing business under the laws of Missouri, at the City of Nevada, in said State, for and in consideration of One Dollar, and for other valuable considerations, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby remise, release, convey, satisfy, discharge and quit-claim unto Flowers Nelson and his wife Birdie Nelson and R. D. Waddell and his wife Ora Waddell of Tulsa Oklahoma all the right, title, interest, claim or demand whatsoever, it may have acquired in, through or by a certain mortgage bearing date of October 20th 1911, and recorded in the office of the United States Clerk and Ex-Officio Recorder at Tulsa, Indian Territory (Now State of Oklahoma) in Book 420, at page 420, to the premises herein described, as follows:

The South Ten (10) of Lot Number Two (2). The South Ten (10) feet of Lot Number Three (3). The North Forty (40) feet of Lots Numbered Four (4) and Five (5), all in Block Number Fifty Nine (59), Tulsa Indian Territory (Now State of Oklahoma), allowing for the variation of lot and block lines from the true meridian, more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point on West line of North Boston Avenue Ten (10) feet Northerly from the Southeast Corner of Lot Two (2), Block Fifty Nine (59), thence Westerly on a line parallel with said Ten (10) feet Northerly from the Southerly line of said Lots Number Two (2) and Three (3) a distance of One Hundred and Forty (140) feet to the alley, thence Southerly along Easterly line of said Alley a distance of Fifty (50) feet, thence Easterly parallel with and Forty (40) feet Southerly from the Northerly line of Lots Number Four (4) and Five (5) of Block Number Fifty Nine (59) a distance of One Hundred and Forty (140) feet to line of said North Boston Avenue, thence Northerly along the West line of said Boston Avenue Fifty (50) feet to place of beginning and all improvements thereon.
