RELEASE OF MORTGAGE.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the FARM AND HOME SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF MISSOURI, a corporation, organized and doing business under the laws of Missouri, at the City of Nevada, in said State, for and in consideration of One Dollar, and for other valuable considerations, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby remise, release, convey, satisfy, discharge and quit-claim unto James M. Cline and his wife Nellie S. Cline and E. E. Charters and his wife Lavada Charters of Tulsa Oklahoma all the right, title, interest, claim or demand whatsoever, it may have acquired in, through or by a certain mortgage bearing date of September 20th 1903, and recorded in the office of the Deputy Clerk of Ex Officio Recorded at Sapulpa, Indian Territory, Now State of Oklahoma in Book 377 at page 377, to the premises herein described, as follows:

The South (S) Fifty Feet of Lot Number two (2) in Block Number Sixty (60), the same being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the Southeast corner of Lot Number Two (2) in Block Number Sixty (60) as shown by the Government Plat of the said town of Tulsa, and running thence North along Main Street Fifty (50) feet, thence West Ninety two (92) feet, thence South Fifty (50) feet, thence East Ninety two (92) feet to place of beginning, in the Townsite of the City of Tulsa, Indian Territory, (Now State of Oklahoma) and all improvements thereon,
