 all the right, title, interest, claim or demand whatsoever, it may have acquired in,
 through or by a certain mortgage bearing date of December 20th 1912, and recorded in the office of Deputy H. S. Clark
and Ex-Officio Recorder Western District, Indian Territory (now State of Oklahoma)
 in Book 46 at page 430, to the premises herein described, as follows:

The North (N) Thirty (30) feet of Lot number six (6) in Block number Four (4); also, a part of Lot number seven (7) in Block number Four (4), described as follows: -
