TRUSTEE'S DEED.

WHEREAS, on the 7th day of October, 1908, J Fred Deed and Nellie E. Deed, his wife, parties grantor, executed and delivered to the UNION TRUST COMPANY, a corporation of the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, as trustee, a deed of trust to the property therein described, known as Buena Vista Park Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, which deed was , on the 9th day of November, 1908, recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in Book 48, at Page 155, in which deed the parties grantor covenanted and agreed to warrant and defend the title to said property, and every part and parcel thereof, to and unto the grantees of the Union Trust Company, as Trustee.
