Party of the second part further agrees that before abandoning any well he will securely plug the same so as to shut off all water above the oil bearing horizon, and agrees to securely shut in or confine the gas in all wells productive of gas in paying quantities.

Party of the second part shall have the right soptain from wells or other sources on the above described land by means of pipe lines or otherwsie, a sufficient supply of water to carry on said operation,s and shall have the right to use oil and natural gas from said premises as fuel so far as it is necessary o to the prosecution of said operations.

Party of the first part shall have the free use of gas for domestic purposes for one residence on the premises, by making his own connections at the well or wells.

It is further agreed that party of the second part may at any time, upon the payment of Ten Dollars and of all outstanding obligations accrued to date which shall have arisen under the terms of this lease, and the filing for record in the office of the register of deeds of the county where the land lies, and the filing of alcopy of the same with the county court, surremer this lease and be thereby discharged and released from all futur e obligations and responsibilities, hereunder; and thereupon this lease shall become null and void, and of of effect; and whatever moneys have been received by the party of the first par part shall be retained by him.
