Now on this the 2nd day of April, A. D. 1910, there comes on for hearing before the Court in open Court at Probate the above entitled matter, upon the return of the Guardian upon order to lease lands of the minor, Roy Grayson, and the Court considers the whole matter and is fully advised, and finds that One Dollar and twenty five cents per acre is the best and highest price that can be obtained for an oil and gas lease upon the said lands of said minor, namely, the North (1/2) of the Northwest quarter (1/4) of Section Twenty-eight (28), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Eleven (11) East of the principal Indian Base and Meridian in Oklahoma, and that said Guardian has made and entered into, subject to the approval of this Court, a lease contract with one J. O. Hamilton, to expire February 3rd, 1924, bearing date this day, upon the terms, considerations, and conditions therein mentioned and set forth, and that said lease is in all things reasonable, proper and fair, and beneficial to the said minor ward and to the estate of the said minor ward, and that it is advisable and expedient that the said lease should be approved.

It is therefore by the Court considered, ordered, adjudged and decreed that the said lease contract be in all things approved, ratified, confirmed and validated, and the Judge of the Court does here and now endorse notation of such approval upon the original and duplicate of said lease contract. It is ordered that a copy of said lease be filed and retained in the papers in this matter, and that one copy be retained by and delivered to each the said Guardian and the said J. O. Hamilton.
