WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred Sixty 00/100 Dollars the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the party of the first part, as such Trustee, has granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the party of the second part his heirs and assigns, the following described real property, lying and situate in the Buena Vista Park Addition to the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lots Seven (?) and Eight (8) in Block One (1) as per seconded plat thereof, together with the tenements, hereditaments, and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever.

The party of the first part covenants and agrees with the party of the second part that, the covenants of warranty and all covenants and agreements by the said parties grantor in said trust deed of date October 7th, 1908, shall run to the party the second part, herein, and that the party of the first part will, as such trustee, forever warrant and defend the title to the said real property, in and to the party of the second part his heirs and assigns, against all claims or acts of the first party and those of all persons claiming by, through a
