REAL ESTATE MORTGAGE.

WITNESSETH, That said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One Thousand, Dollars the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey and mortgage unto said party of the second part her heirs and assigns, all the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

North West quarter of the North west quarter, and west half of the North east quarter of the North west quarter, and the North east quarter of the North east quarter of the North west quarter, of section Thirty three (33) Township Twenty (20) North and Range Fourteen (14) East containing in all seventy acres according to the Government survey thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining forever.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, And these presents are upon this expressed condition, that whereas said Luther O. Gravitt has this day executed and delivered a certain promissory note in writing to said party of the second part, of which the following is a copy. \$1000 Catoosa, Okla. April 6th, 1910.

On or before April, 6th, 1912, after date I promise to pay to the order of Mrs. Maggie Adkison, the sum of One Thousand Dollars, For value received, negotiable and payable at Broken Arrow, Okla. with interest at 8 per cent per annum from date until paid. The makers signers and endorsers, each severally waive presentation for payment, notice of non-payment, protest and notice, and further consent to renewals or extension without further notice.
