C. McGill, of Okla. Co. Okla. the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hereby grants, bargains, sell, and conveys unto the said Mrs. A. C. McGill, her heirs, and assigns, forever, the following described lands in the Cherokee Nation and in the Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

Lot No. 346 in Block No. 27 of Tulsa Heights, according to a map or plat thereof used by said Tulsa Heights Company and filed for record and recorded in the Office of the Clerk of the United States Court and ex-officio Recorder at Tulsa, Indian Territory, the same being a part of that portion of the West half (W 1-2) of the Southwest Quarter (SW 1-4) and the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest quarter (SW. 1-4 of the NW. 1-4) of Section Twenty-nine (29), Township Twenty (20) North, Range Thirteen (13) East.
