Marr a warranty deed conveying Lot Three (3) in block Ninety-one (91) in the city of Tulsa, Western District of Indian Territory; that said deed was dated November 26th 1902 and filed for record August 10th 1905 and acknowledged before affiant as a notary public by the grantors on said 26th day of November 1902 that said deed was again filed for record on October 26th 1908 at 5 P.M. and recorded in Book 48, at page 62 of the records of the Register of Deeds of Tulsa County Oklahoma. that the name of Lucinda Darland was signed to said instrument, at her request, by L. D. Marr, who signed said deed as a witness to the mark of the said Lucinda Darland.

Hodge the East half of the Northwest quarter of the southeast quarter and the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of section one (1) township nineteen (19) north, and range thirteen east, and that he this affiant knows of his own knowledge that Mary Jane Hodge the Allottee of the above land and Mary J. Burnett (nee Hodge) and Mary J. McKee (nee Burnett) is one and the same person, and further affiant says not.
