ORDER CONFIRMING SALE OF REAL ESTATE.

Now, on this 28th day of May, 1910, there coming on for hearing the return of sale made by Alex. S. Lewis, as the guardian of the estate of Floyd Smith, a minor, being the day appointed for hearing said return, and there now appearing herein in person, said Guardian, Alex. S. Lewis, and there also appearing herein James H. McBirney, the bidder upon said land, in his own proper person, and there being no objections made or exceptions filed to said return of sale; and it further appearing to the satisfaction of the court that due notice of this hearing has been given by posting notices thereof in three public places in Tulsa County at least ten days before the day for hearing as required by law and the order of the court; and it further appearing to the court that since said return of sale was filed herein, to-wit: on this 28th day of May 1910, certain other bids in writing for the land hereinafter described have been filed in this court raising and increasing the original bid for said land as reported in said return of sale under the provisions of the statutes in such cases made and provided; and the court having examined said return of sale, and said additional bids filed as aforesaid, and having heard and considered the evidence of witnesses offered in support of said return, and being fully advised in the premises finds;

That in pursuance of an order of sale made and entered herein on the 26th day of April, 1910, said guardian advertised the property hereinafter described for sale for two weeks in the Tulsa Democrat, a newspaper published in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and by posting notices of such sale in three public places in said county at least fifteen days before the day of sale, as required by law and said order of sale, and in accordance with said order and said notices, said guardian on the 14th day of May, 1910, at the time and place therein mentioned
