REAL ESTATE MORTGAGE.

WITNESSETH, That said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One hundred and Ten Dollars the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey and mortgage unto said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, all the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa State of Oklahoma, to-wit:
The South West quarter of the south west quarter of the North west quarter of Section twenty eight (28) Township (20) North and Range Fourteen (14) East, containing in all Ten acres according to the government survey thereof.
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining, forever.
PROVIDED, ALWAYS, And these presents are upon this expressed condition, that whereas, said -----has this day executed and delivered a certain promisory note in writing to said party of the second part, of which the following is a copy, Catoosa, Okla., March 22d 1910. November 15th 1910 after date we promise to pay to the order of L. O. Gravitt the sum of One hundred and Ten dollars for value received, negotiable and payable Catoosa, Oklahoma, with interest at 8 per cent per annum from maturity until paid,.
