WARRANTY DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: that we, Dan J. Davisson and wife Mae Davisson, of the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty eight Hundred forty one & 66/100 (\$2841.66) dollars, cash in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain sell and convey unto C. S. Walker and R.F. Morley, also of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, an undivided two thirds interest in and to the the following described real property and premises situate in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The North fifty (50) feet of Lot six (6) in Block One Hundred and Seventeen (117) of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the official plat thereof, together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances thereunto belonging, and warrant the title to the same.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said described premises unto the said C.S. Walker, and R.F. Morley, their heirs and assigns forever, free, clear and discharged of and from all former grants, charges, taxes, judgments, mortgages and other liens and encumbrances of whatsoever nature, save and except one certain mortgage executed by Dan J. Davisson and wife Mae Davisson, on the 23rd day of May, 1910, for Fifty six Hundred and Eighty three and 33-1/3 (\$5683.33 1/3) in favor of Amelia K. Crowell, administratrix of the estate of Robert A. Crowell, deceased, covering said lands.
