QUIT CLAIM DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT Willie Fulson and Robert Fulson and Willie Fish parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred fifty and no/100 dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby quitclaim Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto Vera Bland and Era Bland the following described real property and premises, situated in Creek County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

An undivided three-sixteenths (3/16) interest in and to the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ less 10.56 acres occupied as right-of-way by the St. L. & S.F. RR Co., and the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 32, Township 19 North, Range 12 East and the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 8, Township 19, North, Range 9, East, containing 159.44 acres more or less according to the government survey thereof, and being the allotment of Kalawee, deceased.

Each of the above grantors owning an undivided one sixteenth (1/16) interest in the above described lands, the same being no part of either of their respective homesteads, together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances thereunto belonging.
