QUIT CLAIM DEED.

WITNESSETH, that the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One and No/100 dollars, to them paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, remise, release and forever quit claim unto the said party of the second part, the following described lots, tracts, or parcels of land lying being and situate in the County of Tulsa, and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

North half of north west quarter of the south east quarter of section twenty four in Township nineteen N of range thirteen E I.M.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, with all the rights, immunities, privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever, so that neither the said parties of the first part nor their heirs nor any other person or persons for themselves or in their names or behalf shall or will hereafter claim or demand any right, or title to the aforesaid premises, or any part thereof, but they and every one of them shall by these presents be excluded and forever barred.
