That we Sue E. Cline and Lewis Cline his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and fifty dollars, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said John A. Burt and Geo. H. Rumrill and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in *the* Tulsa County Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot number sixteen (16) in Block number Seven (7) in the Town of Glenpool Tulsa County Oklahoma according to the recorded plat thereof.

To have and to hold the same unto the said John A. *Burt* and Geo. H. Rumrill and unto their heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said John A. *Burt* and Geo. H. *Rumrill* that they will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I Sue E. Cline wife of the said Lewis Cline for and in consideration of the said sum of money do hereby release and relinquish unto the said John A. Burt and Geo. H. Rumrill all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
