

or across which the said second party may extend its line of railroad and with which it has connections all such cars of freight as may be shipped to any point on the said switch to be erected by said first party; but the use of said switch of said first party shall, at all times, be subject to the reasonable rules and regulations of said second party; and said first party shall, at all times, maintain said switch and grade in good, safe and proper operating condition.

Said second party for the consideration aforesaid further agrees, that on commencing the work on the construction of its said line or railroad, it will properly fence the east side of its right of way lying along said lands of the said first party.

This agreement and all the terms and conditions therein contained shall extend to and be binding upon the heirs, successors and assigns of the parties hereto.
