THIS INDENTURE, Made this 27th day of July 1904, between E.B. Pulliam (a single man) of Rice County, in the state of Kansas, of the first part and Brellia E. Patton of Tulsa Indian Territory, of the second part.

WITNESSETH, that said party of the first part, in consideration of six hundred and no/100 dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents, grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all that tract, lots or parcel of land situated in Tulsa Creek Nation, Indian Territory and described as follows, to-wit: The south one half (S 1/2) of Lot three (3) in Block One hundred twenty nine (129) in the Town of Tulsa, Indian Territory, With the appurtenances, and all the estate, ritle, and interest of the said party of the first part thereon, and the said E.B. Pulliam does hereby covenant and agree that he will warrant and defend the same in the quiet and peaceable possession of the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, against all persons whomsoever, lawfully claiming the same from or under them.
