THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 11th day of February, one thousand nine hundred and seven, by and between Urias F. Myers, and Minnie F. Myers (his wife) of Callaway County, Missouri, parties of the first part, and William N. Birkhead of Callaway County, Missouri, party of the second part;

WITNESSETH, that the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part the following described real estate and premises situate in the Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit: Lots four (4) and five (5) in Block Fourteen (14) in the Feals Addition to the Incorporated town of Broken Arrow, Indian Territory, together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining thereto.

To have and to hold the aforegranted premises to the said William Birkhead and his heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and the said Urias F. Myers and Minnie F. Myers for themselves and their heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said William N. Birkhead and his heirs, successors and assigns that we are lawfully seized in fee of the aforegranted premises; that they are free from all incumbrances; and that we have good right to sell and convey the same to the said William N. Birkhead as aforesaid; and that we will and our successors, heirs, executors, and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said William M. Birkhead and his heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And I, Minnie F. Myers of Callaway County, Missouri, wife of said Urias F. Myers, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said party of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands
