WARRANTY DEED.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 23rd day of March, A. D. 1910, between Solomon Bullett, C-8663, John Bullett, C-8776, Annie Wolf, C-8666, C-6756, Sallie Brown nee Gaino C-6755, heirs at law of Harriett Gano, C-9964, deceased of the first part, and John Hayden and John F. Black of Tulsa, Oklahoma, of the second part.

WITNESSETH, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00) the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa, and State of Oklahoma, to-wit: An undivided two-thirds (2/3) interest in and to the following described land: The Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section thirty-two (32) and the West Half (W $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Thirty-three (33) all in Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Ten (10) East.
