Fife, aged 16 years, and the said Amy Fife, aged eighteen years, children and sole and only heirs of Soda Fife, deceased, in court in person, and no one appearing either in person or by attorney, offering any objections to said return, and the court having taken the evidence in open court, of the said William Anderson, guardian, and the said Bessie Fife and Amy Fife, and having fully considered the evidence offered in support of said return, and having fully examined and investigated the lease herein made, and the terms and conditions thereof, and being fully advised in the premises finds:

That in pursuance of an order of this court, authorizing the said William Anderson, guardian, to make and enter into an oil and gas mining lease, upon the lands of the said Soda Fife, deceased, as herein described, the said William Anderson, Guardian, did on the 7th day of June 1910, make and enter into and One oil and gas mining lease, to Virginia Light, of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, on the following described real estate, to-wit:

The southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of section Fifteen (15) Township Nineteen (19) Range eleven (11) and the North Half of the North west quarter of the Northwest quarter of section twenty two (22) Township Nineteen (19) Range Eleven (11) and the southeast quarter of the south west quarter, and lot six (6) and Lot seven (7), of section fifteen (15) Township Nineteen (19) Range eleven (11) being in all, one hundred and sixty one and 44/100 acres, situate in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, and being the allotment of the said Soda Fife deceased.

at private sale, for the sum of one hundred sixty one (161) dollars, cash bonus a one eighth royalty of the oil produced from said land, and one hundred fifty (\$150) dollars per annum, from each gas producing well, from which gas is sold off the premises. That said lease was made after due notice as prescribed by order of court; that said purchaser was the highest bidder therefor; that said sum the highest and best sum bid; that said lease was legally made; that the said sum and terms thereof, are not disproportionate to the value of the property leased; that a sum exceeding the amount bid on said lease, at least ten per cent exclusive of the expenses of a new lease, cannot be obtained; that the said William Anderson, guardian, in all things, proceeded and conducted and managed said lease, as required by the statutes as in such cases made and provided, and as by said order of court, required and directed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, adjudged and decreed by the court that the said lease, be and the same is hereby confirmed, approved and declared valid, unto the said Virginia Light, upon the terms and conditions therein provided.
