County in the State of Oklahoma, party of the second part, the following described real property and premises, situate in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to-wit: Lots One (1) Two (2) Three (3) four (4) and twelve (12) Block Seven in Factory addition to the city of Tulsa, Oklahoma, as shown by the record thereof as recorded in the office of the register of deeds in and for Tulsa County, Oklahoma, together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances thereunto belonging, and warrant the title to the same.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said described premises unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, free, clear, and discharged of and from all foremr grant⁴ charges, taxes, judgments, mortgages and other liens and encumbrances of whatsoever nature except 1909 taxes.

The Southeast quarter (SE/4) of Northeast quarter (NE/4) of Section Six (6) Township Twenty (20) North, Range Thirteen (13) East of the Indian Base and Meridian, containing 40 acres, more or less.
