suffer no waste to be committed upon the portion in its occupancy or use; to take good care of the same, and to promptly surrender and return the premses upon the termination of this lease to the party of the first part or to whomsoever shall be lawfully entitled thereto, and not to remove therefrom any buildings or improvements erected thereon during the s id term by the sad arty of the second part, but said buildings and improvements shall remain a part of said land and become the property of the owner of the land as a part of the consideration for this lease, in addition to the other considerations herein specified, excepting that tools boilers, boiler houses, pipe lines, pumpting and drilling outfits, tanks, engines and machinery, and the casing of all dry or exhausted wells, shall remain the property of the sadaparty of thesecond part, and maybe removed at any time before the expiration of sixty days from the termination of the lease, that will not permit any nuisance to be maintained on the premises under its control, nor allow any intoxicating liquors to be sold or given away for any purposes on such premises; that it will not use such premises for any other purposes than that authorized in this lease, and that before abandoning any well it will securely plug the same so as to effectually shut off all water above the oil bearing horizon.

And it is mutually understood and agreed that no sublease, assignment, or transfer of this lease or of any interest therein or thereunder can be directly or indirectly made without the written consent theread of the lessor and the Secretary of the Interior first obtained, and that any such assignment or transfer made or attempted without such consent shall be void.

And the said party of thesecond part further covenants and agrees that it will keep an accurate account of all oil mining operations, showing the whole amount of oil mined and removed, and all sums due as royalty shall be a lien on all implement, tools, movable machinery, and other personal chattels used in said prospecting and mining operations, and upon all of the oil obtained from the land herein leased, as security for the payment of said royalties.

And the party of the second part agrees that this indenture of lease shall in all respects be subject to the rules and regulations heretofore or that may hereafter be lawfully prescribed by the secretary of the Interior relative to oil and gas leases in the Cherokee Nation.

And the said party of the second part expressly agrees that should it or its, sublessees, executors,, administrators, successors, or assigns, violate any of the covenants, stipulations, or provisions of this lease, or fail for the period of sixty days to pay the stipulated monthly royalty provided for herein, fun the party of the first part shall be at liberty in his discretion, to add this indenture of lease and cause the same to be annulled, when all the rights, franchises, and privileds of the party of thesecond part its sublessees, executors, administrators, successors, or assigns, hereunder shall cease and end without further proceedings.

If the lessee makes reasonable and bond fide effort to find and produce oil inpaying quantty as is herein required of it, and 4uch effort is unsuccessful it may, at any time thereafter, with the approval of the Secretary of the Interior, surrender and wholly therminate this lease upon the full payment and performance of all its then existing obligations hereunder: Provided, however, that approval of such surrender by thesecretary will be required only during the time his approval of the alienation of the land is required by law.

It is further agreed and understood that this lease shall be of no force
