operating said pipe line; said damage if not mutually agreed upon, to be ascertained and determined by three disinterested plesons, one thereof to be appointed by the said grantor, heirs or assigns, one by The Prairie Oil & Gas Company, its successors or assigns, and the third by the two so appointed as aforesaid, and the award of such three persons shall be final and conclusive. And it is hereby further agreed, that the said The Priarie Oil & Gas Company, its successors or assigns may at any time lay an additional line of pipe alongside of the first line, as herein provided, upon the payment of a like consideration. and subject to the same conditions; also to have the right to change the size of its pipe lines the damage, if any, in making such change to be aid by the said The Prairie Oil & Gas Company. Pipe to be buried 16 inches or more below the surface
