THIS INDENTURE OF LEASE, Made and entered into in quadruplicate on this 25th day of January A.D. 1907 by and between Ellen Hoffman, of Collinsville, Indian Territory, party of the first part, lessor, and The Southwestern Oil, Gas and Coal Company, a corporation of Oolagah, Indian Territory, party of the second part, lessee, under and inpursuance of the provisions of section 72 of the act of Congress approved July 1, 1902, and the regulations prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior thereunder.

WITNESSETH, that the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the royalties, covenants, stipulations and conditions hereinaf contained, and hereby agreed to be paid, observed and performed by the party of the second part, its successors, and assigns, does hereby demise, grant, and let unto the party of the second part, its successors, and assigns, for the term of fifteen years from the date hereo, all of the oil deposits and natural gas inor under the following described tract of land, lying and being within the Cherokee Indian Nation and within the Indian Territory, to-wit: Ne 1/4 of NE 1/4 and NE 1/4 of SW 1/4 of NE 1/4 and W 1/2 of SW 1/4 of NE 1/4 and SE 1/4 of SW 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 25, and the NW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of section 24, township 22 N. range 14 E.
