## TAX DEED.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

Red Fork, Okla. 3/31/1910

That whereas the following described property Lot (4) four Block (37) Thirty Seven Lot (6) Six Block (34) ~~thirty~~ Four, Lots (1) <sup>two</sup> (2) Two, (3) Three & (5) <sup>five</sup> block (34) Thirty four. Lot (1) One Block (35) thirty five and S2 Lot (4) four Block (23) Twenty Three, Town of Red Fork, Okla as shown by the recorded platt thereof, situated in the incorporated town of Red Fork, in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, was subject to taxation for the year 1903, and 4 and whereas the taxes assessed on said real property for the said year of 1903 and 4 aforesaid remained due and unpaid at the date of the sale hereinafter named, and whereas the collector of revenue of the said town did on the 5th day of February 1906, by virtue of the authority in him vested by law, at the sale begun and publicly held on the 5th day of Feb., 1906, in the year 1906, expose to public sale at Red Fork, in said Tulsa county, in substantial conformity with all the requirements of Statute in such case made and provided, the real property above described for the payment of the taxes, penalty and cost then due and remaining unpaid on said property; and whereas at the time and place aforesaid R.
