All the right title and interest of Mose Jefferson, a son and heir of Lena Jefferson deceased, in and to the south west quarter of section (18) Eighteen, Township (19) Nineteen North Range (13) Thirteen east also described as the east ($\frac{1}{2}$) half of the South weest quarter of section (18) Eighteen and Lots three (3) and (4) Four of section (18) Eighteen, Township (19) Nineteen north range (13) Thirteen east and lots one and four of section Thirty six (36) Township (19) North range 12 east all in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, The same being the undivided one third interest of grantors in and to the allotment of Lena Jefferson, deceased.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said Mose Jefferson for his heirs, executors, or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part that at the delivery of these presents that he lawfully seixed in his own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances that the same are free, clear, discharged, and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances of what nature and kind soever, and that he will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part, heirs and assigns, against said party of the first part his heirs and all and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
