THISINDENTURE OF LEASE, Made and entered into in quadruplicate on this 8th day of May A.D. 1907, by and between Christine Orcutt, a minor, by her guardian A.D Orcutt, of Tulsa Indian Territlry, party of the first part, lessor and the March Oil Company a corporation, organized under the laws of the Indian Territory, of Tulsa, Indian Territory, part -- of the second part, lessee, under and in pursuance of the provisions of section 17 of the act of Congress approved June 30, 1902, and the regulations prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior, the reunder.

WITNESSETH, that the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the royalties, covenants, stipulations and conditions hereinafter contained, and hereby agreed to be paid, observed and performed, by the party of the second part, its successors, and assigns, do hereby demise, grant, and let unto the party of the second part, it s successors, and assigns, for the term expiring December 23rd, 1916, from the date hereof, all of the oil deposits and natural gas in or

under the following sescribed tract of land, lying and being within the Creek Indian Nation and and within the Indian Territory, to-wit: The South east one quarter (1) of of section 27, towns 19 range 13, of the indian Meridian, and containing 160 acres, more or less, with the right to prospect for, extract, pipe, store, refine, and remove such oil and antural gas, and to occupy and use so much only of the surface of said land as may be reasonably necess: ry to carry on the work of prospecting for, extracting, piping, storing, refining, and removing such oil and natural gas, including also the right to obtain from wells or other sources on said land, by means of pipe lines or otherwise a sufficient supply of water to carry on said operations, and including still further the right to use such oil and natural gas as fuel so far as it is necessary to the prosecution of said operations.
