ASSIGNMENT OF OIL AND GAS LEASE.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That J.F. Pautler, for and in consideration of Three Hundred and Thirty (\$330.00) dollars, paid by the Rhode Island Oil Company, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does assign, transfer, setover and deliver to the said Rhode Island Oil Company, all his right, title and interest in and to a certain oil and gas lease made, executed and delivered and dated the 21st day of May, 1910, and made by L.P. McGuire, guardian of Oscar McGuire, and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds in Tulsa County State of Oklahoma, in book 79 at page 598, covering certainlands described as follows, to-wit:
