

OIL AND GAS LEASE---RELEASE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That whereas, on the 31st day of May, 1907, a certain lease was executed by Andy Jefferson, lessor to the Truby Oil and Gas Company, a corporation, of Independence Kansas, lessee for certain considerations therein named, upon the following described real estate, viz:

Whereas, in consideration of the release all of claims and demands of every kind and character originating under said lease against said lessee by lessor and any and all persons claiming under him, the above named lessee, does hereby demise, release and forever quit claim all its right, title and interest in and to the above mentioned property, which it the said Truby Oil and Gas Company may have acquired by virtue of said above named lease to said Andy Jefferson, the said lessor his heirs or assigns forever.
