In consideration of which the forty of the second part hereby agrees and binds itself its successors, and assigns to pay or cause to be mid to the United States Indian agent, Union Agency, Indian Territory, for the lessor, as royalty the sum of ten per cent of the sorts proceeds on the lessed premises of all crude oil extracted from the said land, such payment to be made at the time of sale or disposition of the oil; and the lessee shall pay, in yearly paymats, at the end of each year, one hundred and fifty dollars royalty on each gas producing well which it shall use. The lessor shall have the free use of gas for lighting and warming his residence on the premises. It is further agreed that a failur of the part of the lessee to use a gas producing well where the same can not be reasonably utilized at the rate so prescribed shall not work a forfeiture of this lease so far as the same relates to minin g oil, but if the lessee desires toretain gasproducing privileges, it shall pay a royalty of fifty dollars per annum, in advance, on each gas producing well not utilized the first payment to become due and to be made within thirty days from thedate of the discovery of gas.

And the party of the second part further agrees and binds itself its successors and assigns, to pay or cause to be paid to the said agent, for 'lessor, as advanced annual royalty, on this lease the sum of money as follows, to-wit: Fifteen cents per acre per annum, in advance for the first and second y ars, Thirty cents per acre per annum, in advance, for the third and fourth years and seventy five dents per acre per annum, in advance, for the fifth and each succeeding year thereafter of the term for which this lease is to run.; it feing understood and agreed that said sums of money so paid shall be a credit on the stipuleted annual royalties; and further, that should the party of the second part neglect or refuse to fay such advanced annual royalty, for fae partiod of sixty days after the same becomes due and myable, the Secretary of the Interior, after ten days' notice to the parties may declare this lease null and " void, and all royalties paid in advance shall become the money and property of the lessor.

The party of the second part further covenants and agrees to exercise diligence in the sinking of wells for oil and natural gas on the lands covered by this lease, and to drill at least one well thereon within twelve months from the date of the approval of the bond by the Secretary of the Interior, and should the party of the second part, fail, neglect, or refuse to drill at least one well within the time stated, this lease may, in the discretion of the Secretary be debladed null and void, after ten days' notice to the parties; provided, that the lessee shall have the privilege of delaying operations for a period not exceeding five yeaks from thedate of the approval of the bond tabe furnished in connection her; with, by paying to the United States Indian Agnt, Union Agency, Indian Territory, for the use andbenefit of the lessee may be required to immediately develop the tracts leased; should the Secretary of the Interior determine that the interests of the lessor demand such action.

The party of the second part further agrees to carry on perations in a wakmanlike manner to the fullest possible extent, unavoidable casualties excepted; to commit no waste on the staid land, and to suffer no waste to be committed upon the portion in its occupancy or use; to take good care of the same and to promptly surrender and return the premises upon the termination of this
