WAIVER OF OBLIGATION UNDER BOND.

COMPARED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That, whereas, on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of October 1908, the Secretary of the Interior approved an oil and gas mining lease on the allotment of Addie B. Hall, nee Addie B. Mann, said allotment embracing the following described lands:

Southeast quarter of Northwest Quarter of Sec 17 T 17 N.R. 14 E. I.B. & M Tulsa, County, Oklahoma said lease being dated June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 1908, and made by Addie B. Hall, nee Addie B. Mann in favor of the Lowland Oil and Gas Company

(and) WHEREAS, the said Lowland Oil and Gas Company made and executed a bond to the United States of America in the sum of One Thousand dollars (\$1000.00) conditioned upon the said Lowland Oil and Gas Company faithfully performing all the obligations and conditions of the aforesaid lease and observing all the laws of the United States and regulations thereunder made by the Secretary of the Interior; and,

WHEREAS, the Secretary of the Interior, has been relieved by Act of Congress of May 27 1908, of all further jurisdiction of said premises and said lease and is desirous of being relieved of any and all obligations and duties assumed under said bond; and

WHEREAS, the said Addie B. Hall, nee Addie B. Mann has transferred all her right title and interest in and to said land to A. Hickok, <sup>said transfer</sup> having been made on the---day of-----1909

Now, Therefore, I A. Hickok for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do hereby relieve and release the United States of America and the Lowland Oil and Gas Company from all further obligations and duties under said bond made by the National Surety Company, as surety, and

do hereby Substitute for the United States Indian Agency Union Agency, Muskogee, Oklahoma, the Bank of Commerce of Tulsa, Oklahoma, as a place of payment of the rentals and royalties under said lease and do hereby authorize the lessee and his assigns to pay all rentals and royalties falling due under said lease at the said Bank of Commerce of Tulsa, Oklahoma, to the owner of the said land.
