

the regulations heretofore or hereafter prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior respecting oil and gas leases in the Creek Nation, shall render this lease subject to cancellation, after ten days from receipt by it of notice in the discretion of the Secretary of the Interior, whose declaration of cancellation shall be effective without resorting to the court and without further proceedings and that the lessor shall then be entitled to immediate possession of the land.

If, at any time, the Secretary of the Interior after due notice to the persons or parties interested, determines that any person, partnership or corporation has, by means of stock ownership or otherwise, directly or indirectly obtained and holds interests in leases of oil and gas properties in said territory said leases covering in the aggregate an area or more than 4,800 acres, and further finds that the property herein leased is a part of said aggregate area, then the Secretary of the Interior may cancel this lease in the same manner as provided for in the case of any violation of the terms of said lease.

It is further agreed and understood that the approval of this lease shall be of not force or effect, unless the party of the second part furnishes within sixty days from the date of approval of the application filed in connection herewith a bond to the satisfaction of the Secretary of the Interior in accordance with the regulations of March 20, 1905, prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior, which shall be deposited and remain on file in the Indian Office during the life of this lease.
