QUITCLAIM DEED.

COMPARED

The South 1/2 of the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 the North 1/2 of the NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 4, Twp 19 N. and Range 11 East,

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME Together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining to the above described premises, forever, unto the said Joe Abraham, heirs and assigns, so that neither the said Ed Patty and Martha Patty or any person in their name and behalf, shall or will hereafter claim or demand any right, or title to the said premises or any part thereof; but, they, and everyone of them, shall by these presents be excluded and forever barred.
