ASSIGNMENT OIL AND GAS MINING LEASE.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That, Gardner Steel, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, lessee of the herein described lease for oil and gas mining purposes, for, and in consideration of, the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) lawful money of the United States of America, and other good and valuable considerations, to me in hand paid by the Lowland Oil and Gas Company, a corporation, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, at and before the ensealing and delivery hereof, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, assigned and set over, and by these presents does grant, assign and set over unto the said Lowland Oil and Gas Company, as aforesaid, its successors and assigns a certain oil and gas mining lease as follows:

Dated June 20, 1908 from W.A.
