 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do all by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part 2d of the second part,
his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and

of the southeast quarter of section fourteen (14) township nineteen (19)
north range thirteen (13) east containing in all 80 acres more or less

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in
 any wise appertaining forever.

And said Eva Coleman Henderson formerly Eva Coleman
 for herself, her heirs, executors or administrators, do all hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part 2d of the second part,
 that at the delivery of these presents she is lawfully seized in her own right of an absolute and inde-
 feasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of all and all singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances;
 that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and
 incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

and that she will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part 2d of the second part his heirs and assigns,
 against said part 1st of the first part her heirs, and and all every person, whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
